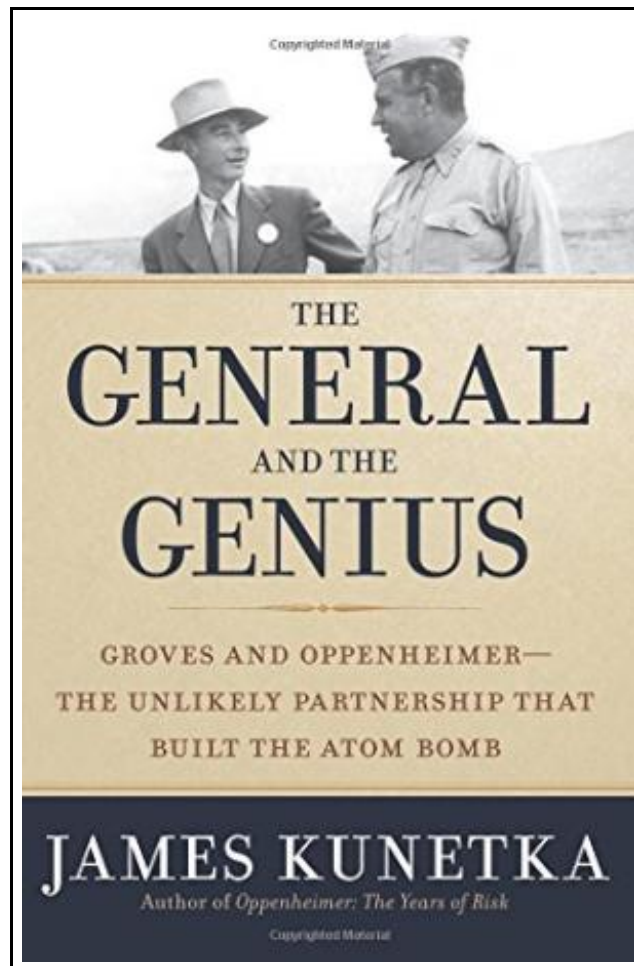

Leslie Richard Groves of the Army Corps of Engineers had built the Pentagon in record time and under budget; put in charge of the Manhattan Project, his mission was to beat the Nazis to the atomic bomb. "Having previously written on the subject (1978's *City of Fire* and 1981's *Oppenheimer, Year of Risk*), Kunetka here uses original records and correspondence to produce a fast-paced recounting of the two-and-a-half-year Manhattan Project. Kunetka highlights the unlikeliness of their positive relationship and attributes it to the qualities they shared: both were intelligent, self-aware, patriotic, and capable of prodigious amounts of work. He also simplifies the physics to be understandable to lay readers.
